An Charming early 18th century needlework picture Circa 1720 worked in both gros and petit point in coloured wools, with some silk highlighting, depicting the finding of Moses in the bulrushes. The colours are good and strong for the period and shows great detail to the flora and fauna including a squirrel in the oak leaves and a swan in the water protecting the babe. It is in a later simulated rosewood frame with museum non reflective glass. There is a little damage at the top which can be seen in main pic between the squirrel and the bird.
