The decorated rectangular shaped top above 2 breakfront drawers which have tiny silver plated snails for handles (one missing). Below are 2 beautifully decorated doors which open to reveal a fabulous interior with 5 graduated drawers all with white metal cloud shaped handles, 2 sliding doors and an open recess with shelf. Two further drawers join the shaped frieze and the cabinet stands on a conforming stand which has a further 2 drawers and shaped legs. The whole decorated throughout with many shades of very good raised gold lacquer and ornately chased copper fittings.
