The removable 4-branch candelabra tops with intricately-cast arms, all complete with the original sconces and bobèches. The fluted stems with crisp-cast details and Empire-inspired designs motifs. Can be used as either elegant single candlesticks or as impressive 4-candle candelabras. In excellent original condition, with a mellow patination to the gilded bronze.
