Adjustable screen height within a range of 71cm (28"). Raised upon an eye-catching carved foliate stand with gently chamfered forms. Long foliate baluster support with acanthus bulb terminus. Standing upon a trio of squat cabriole legs with scrolled toes. This is a striking antique pole screen. Quality Rosewood and needlepoint present superbly and will enhance any fireside setting.
