The seats with solid panels , the legs all united by stretchers , together with simple decorative friezes and flat foot-rests . In excellent original condition with a rich colour and patina. The quality and weight of the rosewood or 'hongmu' timber is outstanding, and both chairs are in first-class condition with no damage or loose joints .
