Cantled corners to the base and moulded foot with ogee bracket feet. Painted 'strawberry blossom' dial with rolling moon phases to the arch, seconds dial and date aperture. Made by John Bradshaw of Manchester. Superb fully restored original movement with bell striking to the hour. Good colour and polish throughout.
