The crisp ormolu (finely gilded bronze), beautifully modelled and chased, is mounted with exquisite Sèvres style porcelain. Porcelain has a blue ground and is delicately painted with a delightful scene of a gentleman and lady seated in a country setting, he serenading her with a lute. The lower porcelain panel is painted with floral swag and the dial is decorated with musical motifs and roses, allegorical of love. The clock is complete with it's original gesso base. Please note that this style of clock does not have a glazed bezel or a rear door. The French movement is of very high quality as one would expect of Japy Freres. It has the Japy Freres 'Medaille d'Honneur' mark on the movement backplate. It is in excellent clean and running condition having been fully serviced by our clockmaker. Pendulum is original. It runs for 8 days on one wind and strikes the hours and halves on a bell. We have a video of the clock running, please ask for a link. Condition of the case is excellent with a clean and bright finish, there is some very minor wear to ...

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
