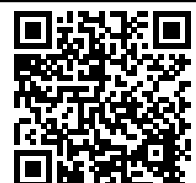

This is delightfully decorated with flowers, leaves and butterflies on a bright turquoise background. (Cloisonné (from the French word 'cloison', a compartment or 'cell') is a form of detailed and complex decoration where the object is applied with very fine wire divisions, which are filled with different coloured enamels and then fired and polished. Exquisite quality; no damage or 'bruises'. 7.5ins (19cms) high. ** (The Meiji period of Japanese history extended from 1868 until 1912. This era comprised the first half of the Empire of Japan, when the country moved from a disparate and isolated feudal society, to a modern industrialised and powerful nation).
