The table rests on 3 fluted pillars with swept supports, ending on brass paw feet caps and castors. It measures a massive 355cms (11 feet and 7 ½ inches) when it is fully extended with a depth of 115cms (45 ¼ in) and a height of 74cms (29 in). Each end piece measures 80 cms (31 ½ in) wide, both leaves measure 53.5cms (21 in) wide and the center leaf measures 87cms (34 ½ in). It would easily seat 12 people. It can also be used without the leaves in place for a more intimate setting. Sympathetically refinished in our workshops, this beautiful table is offered for sale in excellent condition, with a wonderful colour and finish, ready to go straight into the home.
