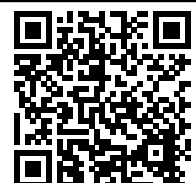

They worked together until 1799. The spoon is a good silver gauge and is a little shorter than traditional basting spoons, measuring 10.2 inches long. Hallmarks: IH over IP for John Hampston & John Prince Date between 1780 and 1784. Leopard's head Lion Passant. Condition: Very good condition. No dents to the bowl. Not engraved. Good set of marks.
