Description

Thomas Russell & Son was a well respected business having achieved a Royal Warrant as watch and clock makers to the Queen and the Duke of Edinburgh. In 1881 the company started importing movements from Switzerland, such as the one we have in this particular watch, a stem-winding 10-jewel movement which is working nicely. The movement is fully signed, including the Tempus Fugit logo, and the serial number 36336. The movement is protected by an inner hinged cover. The watch measures 50.5mm diameter excluding the winding stem and the loop. The case is gold plated and was made by the Illinois Watch Case Company. The case has light surface marking from use and some slight rubbing to the top of the front cover but overall it is in nice condition for a 1920s piece. The winding crown pushes in to open the front cover. Inside there is a glass lens which is in nice condition. The signed double sunk dial is in lovely condition with original blued steel hands, a subsidiary seconds dial and an outer minute track. The watch comes in a new presentation box.
