An outstanding example of this rare and sought-after clock. Superb mahogany case in original condition with rosewood embellishments. A Grande Ssoneree is often referred to as a "blind man's clock" since it is the only type of clock where you can determine the time without looking at the clock. This is because it strikes the quarters on one set of rods followed by the hour on another set of rods. e.g. at, say, 3.15 the clock will strike once on one rod (quarter past) followed by three strikes on a different rod (three O'Clock.). Enamelled dial, triple weight, striking on the quarters and the hours on rods. Stamped G.B. on the striking block. Latch-plate movement. This clock has just been fully overhauled and serviced. A true collectors clock.
