The hood with fretted panels having dentil cornice surmounted by fine swan neck pediment. The case is in very fine original condition with only slight damage to fretwork in hood. Case is a lovely soft colour with fine waxed patina. The movement has just been fully overhauled and is in perfect working order. Comes with all keys. A very fine example of its kind.
