An unusual solid sterling silver roller blotter incorporating two lidded stamp compartments. Dating from the Edwardian era, it is hallmarked for Chester 1905 and has the maker's mark for James Deakin & Sons. The stamp compartments, one double and the other a large single space, have hinged lids which make photographing quite tricky! The wooden base is showing some signs of wear on the sides and there are a couple of small bruises on the silver handle but these signs of wear do not detract from what is an attractive and unusual desk item.
