The body has two cartouches one of which is blank; the other has a later added engraving of a stag. The jug retains the original vibrant gilt interior. Despite being almost 185 years old, this fabulous Solid Silver Jug is in excellent condition with very little sign of use or wear and is a superb piece in amazing condition for its age.
