Also known as a Garniture De Chiminee which is the French description for a clock set, which would be on the mantle piece of a fireplace. The clock has a central enamelled and painted dial in a marble case with fine ormolu mounts, the central finial flanked by attendant bronze cherubs. The matching candelabra having three finely cast ormolu sconces also with attendant cherubs and supported on a marble base with Roman columns again with fine ormolu mounts. French circa 1890-1900
