The bay horse standing proud with its owner and jockey with the race course in the distance. Good perspective and colour. The artist has captured the horse particularly well especially in scale and definition. The canvas is stamped on the reverse and supplied by the famous George Rowney & Co. London The addresses of 64 Oxford Street & Princes Hall, Piccadilly dates it from around 1880. The firm have an impressive history dating back to the 1700's and are still in existence today as Daler-Rowney. We are currently researching the painting and in particular the racing colours worn by the jockey. Sizes given are framed.
