This superb item is a silver bone holder for carving lamb. The correct French name is Manche a gigot d'agneau and being smaller, it would have been for lamb rather than ham or pork. It is a delightful design with a carved ivory handle and hallmarked silver terminal. The holder is an early example and was made and retailed in Paris 1845 -55. The terminal has a screw mechanism for tightening on the bone. A handsome and rare item with a practical use. Dimensions below.
