The nest consists of a set of three matching interlocking tables, each has a rich flame mahogany oval inlaid panel surrounded by ebony and boxwood stringing. They are raised on turned legs and splay feet with verso marks for the maker and retailer Gullachsen & Son Ltd, Newcastle on Tyne.
