An attractive and small sized honey-oak (light coloured) table clock by Fairer of Bishopsgate Without, London. The 8-day movement is fusee driven and strikes on a bell, once, each time it passes the hour (called a 'passing strike') powered by the same single fusee. Original brass pendulum with securing travel-bolt. The silvered dial is beautifully engraved with leaves and flowers, and embossed with the makers name "FAIRER" and has its original black painted hands. Serial number '990' (engraved on dial).
