Description

Good 18th century George 3rd Scottish mahogany serpentine shaped chest of drawers. Dating from around 1770 this is a very nice example of this popular form of Scottish chest. It is also a lovely mellow colour with original patination and waxed finish. The chest has 2 over 3 drawer configuration, the drawers with cock beaded edge and fancy boxwood line inlay. The drawers are pine lined with original iron locks and rococo type brass swan neck handles. The chest stands on its original shaped bracket feet. The top is serpentine shaped on the sides as well as the front and has a nice shape thumb moulding to the edge. One of the more unusual features of this chest of drawers is that it has a fitted lift up writing top in the first long drawer which also has an oval shell inlay to the front. This is all original. The chest is basically in very good condition, there are one or two old veneer repairs to the thin bits between the drawers but otherwise very nice.
