Description

Over the years, I have seen high-quality soumak weaving by the Kordi tribes of the Quchan area of north-east Persia, but the work in this pair of storage-bags has to be the very best I've come across. Acquired recently from a private collection, these bags which might have been woven around 1900-1920 are just incredible! They are both in near-mint condition, complete with original plain-weave backs which have horizontal bands of soumak weave, and a wonderful array of natural colours throughout. They really have to be seen to be fully appreciated, which, of course, is generally the case with all rugs and bags of high quality. I have bought them as a pair and therefore, they should remain together. Size: 94cm x 78cm (3' 1" x 2' 7") and 99cm x 74cm (3' 3" x 2' 5").

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
