For sale, a rare early Twentieth Century cased musical saw by Jedson. This superbly preserved relic from the days of music hall and cabaret entertainment comes complete with its original instructions and is described as follows: "The same is true of a musical saw that is true of any other musical instrument. Some are made of material of good quality and produce good music; others are made of cheap quality and they make strange noises. With this in mind the first thing to be taken into consideration is your saw. Not all saws are musical ones. Some are too short, too long, too stiff, and some are tempered too hard or too soft. The JEDSON Musical Saw may be used as a carpenter's tool without harming it in any way as a musical instrument. The more exercise the saw is given the more flexible it will become and the easier it will be to bend and vibrate it. With this in consideration you may use the "JEDSON" Musical Saw for every purpose that an ordinary saw is made for. Finger print marks will develop into rust marks in a couple of days. Always wipe of the saw with a dry or oiled rag to keep it free from rust marks. Rust marks DO NOT however, harm the tone value of the inst..."

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
