The sugar bowl of oval helmet form with repousse chased bird, foliate and scroll decoration and raised on a decorative lobed spreading foot, the taper handled sifter with cast vine decoration. Presented in it's original leathered casket with blue silk and velvet interior. There is no mistaking its unique quality and design, which is certain to add a special something to your silver collection.
