A landscape Oil on Canvas painting depicting a "Bridge over the river Medway in the village of Aylesford, Kent". The bridge and some local boats moored in the foreground, with a row of Alms Houses and a church behind. Mounted in a gilt frame. In good overall condition. Edward H Niemann, (active 1863-1887) was the son of his more famous (painter) father Edmund Niemann. Edward was a landscape painter from London. He was one of the more prolific and successful of the high Victorian topographical painters. He exhibited a landscape 'near Maidstone, Kent' in Birmingham. According to Wood, his style is similar to that of his father, but a little coarser and broader in terms of his colour palette.
