A small oil on panel by East Anglian Artist Robert Burrows (1810-1883) Depicting figures in a wooded lane, it is signed and housed in a gilt frame. A hand written label verso with presentation inscription between two Ipswich residents and dated 1888. The panel measures 18cm X 13cm Framed it measures 31cm X 27cm We can deliver free of charge in UK mainland. Payment by bank transfer or Paypal Robert Burrows (1810-1883) Born at Ipswich in 1810, eldest son of Robert Burrows (1782-1863), silversmith in the Old Cattle Market, Ipswich, and his wife Elizabeth née Cordy. Apprenticed to the family trade and in 1847 Robert was carrying on the family business at 40 Silent Street and on 1 November the same year elected, unopposed, a liberal Town Councillor and again, without opposition, in 1850 and 1853 but three years later when opposed, was defeated. In 1832 elected a member of the Ipswich Society of Professional and Amateur Artists. He exhibited two landscapes at the Royal Academy.
