The backs are decorated with egg and dart moulding and acanthus scrolls. Each central bowfront drawer is flanked by a long drawer on each side. The drawers have hand-cut dovetails, are solid mahogany lined and have their original gilt brass handles. They are raised on acanthus leaf decorated cabriole legs terminating in carved lion paw feet. The attention to detail is absolutely fantastic and they are certain to attract attention wherever placed.
