Silver plate offers a bright, quality appearance. Monogrammed shield to the front with ornate cursive initials for 'HH'. 5 compartments for placement of each of the condiments vessels. Each is resplendent in quality, diamond pattern glass with silver plated collars. Salt and pepper shakers with delicate pierced lids. Two spirit vessels with matching cut glass stoppers. Condiment caddy with silver plated spoon, held in place by a pleasing hinged lid. The spoon hallmarked with WP inside a diamond and L for London Hallmarks to base of rack read 'PA & SS' with serial number, for Philip Ashbury and Sons of Sheffield. Standing upon four distinctive claw feet to each canted corner - charming scrolled knees above.
