A further drape painted with floral scroll beneath the sconces, which are painted with further floral scroll, upon a gilt ground. The drapes attached with straps, painted with a continuous band of bamboo, on a green ground. Having gilt ears and tails. 6 ¼ in. (15.8 cm.) high Medium: Porcelain Height: 16 cm, 6 1/4". Width: 17 cm, 6 5/8". Depth: 11.5 cm, 4 1/2". Condition: Very minor wear to the gilding. No damage. No restoration.
