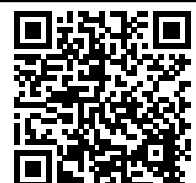

Deep, dark hues and wisps of bright amber tones shine beneath the wax polish finish. Tall proportions set the cabinet apart. Field panel front door carved with patera to centre and panel corners. Distinctive Greek key decoration to upper fascia. Dressed with an inset working lock — key present. Interior arranged as three shelves. Raised upon four square section legs, with pierced, carved brackets adding a flourish to each side. Depository label to rear marked for noted Rear Admiral, Ernest Henry Shattock. Distinguished career within the Royal Navy and later author of 'An Experiment in Mindfulness'. This is a rare and attractive vintage ship's cabinet. Crafted from Coromandel, also known as Calamander, this sought-after wood is native to India and Sri Lanka.
