A good example of a burr walnut knee hole desk in the early Georgian style. Dating to the late 19th century and of excellent construction in solid walnut with attractive burr walnut veneers onto a solid oak carcase. Of gentle serpentine form with the top and drawer fronts being cross-banded. There is an arrangement of one long central drawer flanked by two sets of 4, shorter, graduated drawers. All fitted with their original charming brass handles. To the knee hole there is a bow-fronted cupboard (lockable with key supplied) which opens to reveal a shelved interior. Above this is a "secret drawer". The whole desk stands on elegant shaped bracket feet. Sympathetically refinished in our workshops and now offered for sale in excellent condition.
