Brass inset moulding surrounding the dial face. Arched side apertures with fretwork behind glass panels. An arched painted dial with strike/silent blued steel hand to the arch. Blued steel hands and a date aperture to the lower section of the dial. An 8-day duration verge escapement, twin fusee mechanism striking the hours on a bell. A well engraved floral backplate to the mechanism. William Pearce of London is recorded in Baillies "Watchmakers & Clockmakers of the World" as working in London from 1804.
