A convex painted dial with blued steel hands and signed "Brown, Charing Cross, London". A glass back door to the twin fusee mechanism striking the hours on a bell. A border engraved backplate with the makers name Brown, Charing Cross engraved on it. A pull repeat cord. Circa. 1805. John Brown of Charing Cross, London is recorded in Baillies "Watchmakers & Clockmakers of the World" book as working from 1785 -1811.
