A handsome antique Charles II period three panelled inlaid oak coffer dating from circa 1680. It features a three panelled lid above a guilloche carved top rail, nulled muntins and three chequer inlaid lozenges and stands on stile supports. The lid lifts to reveal a candle box to the interior and what appears to be its original lock and escutcheon. A really good example with a pleasing colour and good details, it is also a relatively small size at 103cm wide and has good height in its legs. Construction/Wood: Oak & Inlay Condition Report: Really good original warm patina to the oak. It is solid and sturdy with wear and marks commensurate with age. An interesting old cast iron strap to one leg which is solid. Some evidence of old worm to one of the front panels, with a small gap. Interior till formerly lidded.
