Description

Mid C19th mahogany table with a shaped top on carved tripod base in the manner of Gillows of Lancaster. High quality mahogany top-top rectangular occasional or lamp table with a shaped 'cusped' outline and panelled rounded-edge top. Raised on a swollen turned column supported on 3 carved and shaped legs, the carved scroll feet fitted with their original brass castors. The figured solid mahogany top secured to the block of the base with brass removable 'thumb-screws' held by bearers, and held in the flat position with a traditional brass 'banjo' shaped catch release. The reverse of the top also being polished, being a further indication of the overall quality of the table. The shape of the top being similar to the designs recognised as those used by the renowned cabinet-making firm of Gillows of Lancaster and London. In excellent original condition, has been cleaned and waxed in our workshops. H 30" W 21" D 25" England c.1850
