Late C19th Hepplewhite revival George III period style mahogany chair-back settee. Elegant small-scale double shield-back mahogany-framed settee with 'Prince of Wales' feather plumes and satinwood inlaid 'wheatsheaf' detail, open carved detail panel to the centre joining the two decorative chair-backs. The whole frame with box-wood stringing detail. Serpentine shaped front seat, raised on box-wood strung square-section tapering legs with 'spade' feet. The shaped out-swept arms each with a satinwood inlaid circular fan patera to the ends. A finely-made decorative settee which would work well as a window seat or in a bedroom setting. Stripped back to the original hessian base covering ready for re-upholstery to client's own specification. The frame in excellent original condition with a minor historic repair to the centre of the back frame. All inlay present and complete. H (full) 36" H (seat) 15" W 43" D 20" England c.1870
