The square canopies are formed of attractive pierced galleries each holding thirty plus beads and crystal lustres. A beautiful pair of wall sconces that were discovered in a box wrapped in a news paper from the 1970s where they had laid for almost fifty years. Totally discoloured and almost black, they have been cleaned and gently restored back to their former glory. A beautiful pair of lights that would grace any interior.
