Exceptional mid 19th.c. Anglo-Indian padouk breakfast dining table c.1850. A superb example, at 61" diameter considerably larger than most, big enough to comfortably seat 8 people. Top made from two broad solid padouk boards, symmetrically arranged and with a gadroon carved edge over a superb carved foliate frieze around the apron. Raised on a square tapering column with moulded upper section and lower portion carved with an acanthus plant motif, gadroon carved collar (old damage to one corner) and base. On a low four pointed plinth with particularly well carved scrolling acanthus leaf feet. The top can be tipped to vertical when not in use, locking flat with the original brass catch.
