Clear, crisp hallmarks are visible on both the blade and where the handle is attached to the silver (see images), for the Sheffield Assay office and a date mark for 1900, along with the Lion Passant indicating the finest sterling silver and silver maker's mark for the silversmith: Arthur Priestley & Co. The knife comes in the attractive original royal blue velvet and satin lined presentation case. This is an exceptional cake knife and would be wonderful as a wedding gift, for use at a wedding or for any celebration cake. It is in super condition.
