Description

Handsome matched pair of early 19th.c. French Empire mahogany open armchairs c.1830. Solid mahogany frames and unusual upholstery with Empire style motifs to the backrest and seats. Very slight differences in design. Both with curved cresting rails and rear stiles, shaped arms with scrolling terminals. Webbed seats over a mahogany veneered apron raised on shaped front legs carved with papyrus leaf detail. Note how the papyrus leaf is repeated on the arms of one chair where they meet the rear stiles. Some wear to the covers, though clean and serviceable. Otherwise very good colour and condition, frames have been cleaned and waxed in our workshops. Dimensions: width 22½", depth 23", height 35½".
