The front with an arrangement of 9 graduated drawers, the reverse fitted with two locking cupboard doors and 3 faux drawer fronts which open to reveal the unique feature of an arrangement of secret pigeon holes. All raised on plinth bases. Fully restored and offered in showroom condition. Provenance: Sourced by direct decent from the family of Sir Charles Barry 1795 - 1860, the British architect best known for his role in the rebuilding of the Palace of Westminster during the mid - 19th Century.
