Staffordshire pottery figure of King Charles I, Thomas Parr factory, c. 1860. The King, wearing a plumed hat, and standing next to a square pedestal, upon which rests a scroll. His sword resting against the support, behind him. Set upon a grassy mound base, above a single gilt line. Medium: Earthenware Height: 27 cm, 10 5/8". Width: 10.2 cm, 4". Depth: 7 cm, 2 3/4". Condition: Firing crack to reverse. Minor loss to the overglaze black enamel. Please see images for detail.

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
