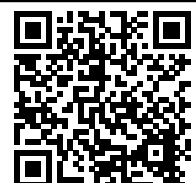

This wonderful quality walking stick has a decorated silver collar which is fully hallmarked for 1922 and bears an inscription in Welsh which reads cyflwynedig gan dosbarth ysgol sul salem newydd i mr thomas duggan ar ei brioddas auraid mawrth 27 1930 (Presented by Salem Newydd School Class to Mr Thomas Duggan on his Golden Wedding March 27 1930). This beautiful walking stick that would make a wonderful gift is a great collector's piece for a walking stick collector and is in good usable condition. Date: 1922.
