There is a central oval vacant cartouche, which could be engraved by your silversmith if desired. The interior is beautifully fitted in a deep plum coloured velvet for eight rings, so a good size for a ring box. The silver of course bears the English silver hallmark for Birmingham 1900, the last year of Queen Victoria's reign. The makers mark D&F is also present for the silversmith, Deakin & Francis.
