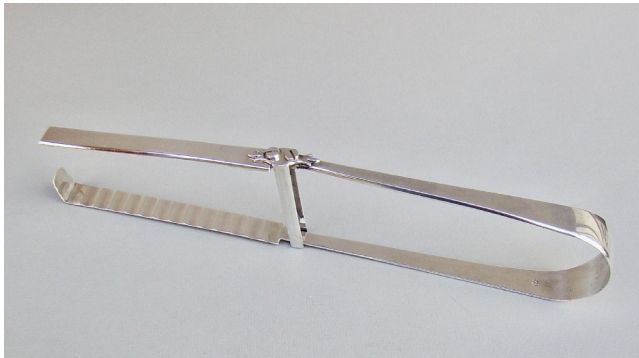

The flexion of the narrow rectangular blades restrained by a plain rectangular bracket. The bracket with decorative finials and retaining the original silver screws. The lower blade corrugated. Crested and initials to the inner handle. They have a good gauge of silver, a testimony of their quality. Hallmarks: TN over GB for Thomas Northcote and George Bourne Lion Passant. Duty Mark.
