A fine pair of Bronzes by J. Boese (1856-1917) depicting Knights in full regalia. 360mm high, 130mm wide and 130mm deep. German. Circa 1910. Boese was originally trained as a wood carver, then attended the vocational school in Gleiwitz. In 1877, he enrolled at the Prussian Academy of Arts where he studied sculpture with Fritz Schaper. After five years, he joined the Master Class taught by Albert Wolff.
