This absolutely charming Qashqa'i rug was made by the Shesh Boluki sub-tribe in Fars, south-west Persia circa 1900-1910. It has a beautiful, deep, indigo-blue field in the highest quality, lustrous, glossy wool showing an abundance of animal and bird life, including stylised lions. The last carcass of a lion was found in the Zagros Mountains in the 1950s by Mr Bob MacQuillan of New Zealand, who was exploring in that region. Size: 1.88m x 0.86m (6' 2" x 2' 10").
