The box opens to reveal a writing surface covered with later purple baize, and compartments for pens, inkwells and paper. All hinges open and close with ease. A lock mechanism is in place internally, however the key hole has been covered with mother of pearl externally. There is some wear to the wood in places commensurate with age but the writing slope remains in a very good condition overall.
