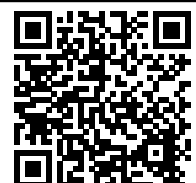
Rare George III period mahogany pyramid-form whatnot; the four graduated shelves with serpentine apron-pieces, fitted with an oak-lined drawer and with exceptionally slender turned supports.
