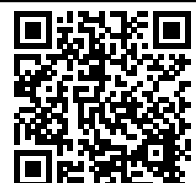

An unusual Japanese cloisonné koro and cover, Meiji Period. The rectangular shaped koro, unusually painted to either side, with enamel panels of figures in garden settings, in Satsuma pottery style; further roundels to either end, painted in similar taste. The black ground, with a dense whorl motif, and decorated with flowerheads, and roundels of stylised flowers. Having a similar decorated rectangular cover, surmounted by a bud finial. Medium: Cloisonné Height: 8.5 cm, 3 1/4". Width: 12 cm, 4 3/4". Depth: 9 cm, 3 1/2". Condition: Excellent. No damage. No repair.
